

Overseas Qualified Nurses Program Pathways

Overseas Qualified Nurses Australian Nursing Induction Program



Note: This is an unaccredited course program and is not listed for CRICOS as it is an Initial Registration for Overseas Nurses Program. The course is designed to provide participants with the knowledge, skills and understanding to practice as a nurse safely and competently in a variety of health care settings. The equivalent of 3 weeks clinical placement may be undertaken optionally as part of this program.

Certificate IV in ESL (Further Study)



The Certificate IV in ESL (Further Study) will allow participants to study for up to 20 weeks to increase their English Language proficiency. Students will have the Oxford placement test administered to establish English language proficiency. This program may be undertaken concurrently to the Overseas Qualified Nurses Australian Nursing Induction Program.

IELTS 6 Equivalent Outcome

(Above 149 to 168 on Oxford placement Test)

Bachelor of Nursing (Post-Registration) with Advanced Standing



Note: Participants in this program will need a study visa to undertake the program. A letter of offer will be issued by the University of Ballarat/Australian Academy of Nursing to participants completing the AISI Overseas Qualified Nurses Australian Nursing Induction Program. This is normally a 12 month course program, however, with Advanced standing arrangements, the course can be completed in 10 months.

(Above 169 on Oxford placement Test)

Return to Practice for Division 1 Registered Nurse and Initial Registration for Overseas Nurses (IRON) with Advanced Standing



Note: Participants may credit any clinical placement undertaken during the Overseas Qualified Nurses Australian Nursing Induction Program to a maximum of 3 weeks in the IRON program. Evidence of IELTS 7 may be required.
